

Japanese Language

This subject helps participants to develop comprehensive language skills of conversation, grammar, reading and writing.

Traditional Culture and Life in Kyoto

Participants will have an opportunity to deepen their understanding in the traditional culture and life in Kyoto, also will have in-depth insight of different culture of not only Japan but also other culture, value and perspective by discussion with Doshisha students. There will also be special lectures to invite leaders of traditional culture in Kyoto as guest speakers.

Placement

Participants are asked to fill in an Online Japanese proficiency questionnaire that is used for class allocation. Each class is usually kept to a small group of about ten students.

Supporting system by Doshisha students is ready to assist participants in studying easy in mind. In "Traditional Culture and Life in Kyoto" classes there will be discussion sessions to interact with Doshisha students. Additionally, some events are organized to interact with Doshisha students.

②High school diploma or above

※Priority will be given to students from Doshisha's partner institutions in case the number of applicants exceeds the quota.

※Applications from overseas are also welcomed.
